New Turf

During the Summer, the Lakefront SC Indoor complex had a major upgrade, the installation of the new Turf Field. Installed by A-Turf, headquartered in Western New York, you may recognize their work from the Buffalo Bills Stadium as well as the turf at Webster High School Athletic Fields. This new turf is designed and built for exceptional traction and foot release, plus consistently true ball release. We are so excited for our teams to start playing on it this year. With new turf we want to remind everyone of our indoor rules:

- I. No gum, food or drinks beside water are allowed on the turf
- II. Shin Guards are **REQUIRED** during all practice and games
- III. Cleats are allowed but not metal studded cleats
- IV. All Players must keep all equipment and personal belongings in their bags
- V. Wear our practice t-shirts to all training sessions
- VI. Balls are to be used only when on the field.
- VII. No bouncing or kicking balls off the walls
- VIII. No balls are allowed on the second floor
- IX. No sliding on turf
- X. Do not pull and pick on the turf grass blades
- XI. No hanging on the goals or black netting
- XII. Only coaches and players are allowed on the turf
- XIII. Do not use emergency exit doors
- XIV. The facility is always open unless a State of Emergency in Monroe County is issued
